The KIJHL wants to give recognition to their players who develop their academic career aspirations, at the same time nourishing their interest in hockey.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

All bursary candidates must be at least a two-year veteran of the KIJHL, who are in their graduating year of high school or have already graduated from high school at the time of application.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. Sportsmanship
2. Hockey ability and performance or quality of contribution
3. School and community participation

## **HOW TO APPLY**

1. Submit a KIJHL Bursary Application form or forward name, address, phone number and a personal letter of application which specifically outlines hockey achievements
2. Name of team(s) played for and years of play
3. Copy of school record
4. Reference letter(s) from school(s) or teacher(s)
5. Reference letter from former team(s)

## **SELECTION**

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee from the KIJHL, with the goal of awarding bursaries in each of the following Conferences Eddie Mountain and Neil Murdoch.

## **BURSARY AVAILABILITY**

The KIJHL bursaries will be made available to the successful applicants after proof has been received that they are attending the Canadian Post Secondary Institution of their choice. All Cheques will be payable to the successful applicant and the Institution. KIJHL Bursary winners may defer receipt of their awards for a period no longer than one academic year
