

APPLYING FOR THE 2022/23 KIJHL BURSARY

The Kootenay International Junior Hockey League is now accepting bursary applications for the 2022/23 season. The deadline for submissions is March 15, 2023.

A total of 12 KIJHL Bursaries in the amount of \$1000 are awarded each year to current players and game officials who best exhibit through their application the following characteristics:

- 1. Academic achievement;
- 2. Sportsmanship;
- 3. Quantity and quality of junior hockey participation;
- 4. Community participation and service.

In order to be eligible to receive a KIJHL bursary, applicants must have completed at least one full season in the KIJHL.

Preference is given to applicants who intend to play collegiate hockey while pursuing their post-secondary education, but continued participation in the sport is not mandatory. Applications received will be reviewed with the goal of awarding bursaries in each of the KIJHL's four divisions as well as to two game officials.

Applicants must submit the following prior to the application deadline:

- 1. A completed KIJHL Bursary Application Package;
- 2. An introductory letter from the applicant outlining why they are applying for a KIJHL Bursary;
- 3. A copy of the applicant's most recent high school transcript;
- 4. A copy of the applicant's most recent post-secondary transcript, if applicable;
- 5. A reference letter from a current or past teacher or school administrator;
- 6. A reference letter from the Head Coach and/or President of the applicant's current KIJHL team.

Successful applicants must register on a full-time basis at a recognized university, college, trade or vocational institution within 18 months in order to receive their award.
