- 2. What year would you want me to start if I committed to your school?
- 3. Where is your school located? How does one get there from here?
- 4. What are the admittance criteria and process for your school?
- 5. Do I fit the academic criteria?
- 6. What academic programs are available at your school?
- 7. Do you have programs in _____ (list fields you are interested in)?
- 8. What are the strengths of your school? What is it most well known for?
- 9. What are undergraduate class sizes like?
- 10. Describe your campus and the facilities and services available to students.
- 11. Where do freshman players usually live? What about the veterans?
- 12. Do you have academic support programs available to your players?
- 13. What is a typical academic load for a first-year player? What does a typical day look like?
- 14. Are we free to take the courses we want? What do you recommend?
- 15. Must players maintain a minimum academic average to be eligible?
- 16. Have Canadian players had success transferring their degrees to jobs in Canada?

- 17. What is the history of your hockey program?
- 18. Who are the coaches and what are their coaching approaches?
- 19. How do the coaches relate to the players?
- 20. How would you describe the culture and atmosphere around the hockey team?
- 21. What are the goals for the team next year and beyond?
- 22. Who are the team leaders and why?
- 23. How do you see me fitting in with the team and your philosophy?
- 24. Who do you have at my position? Will I have an opportunity to play much in my first year?
- 25. Describe your hockey and athletic facilities? (arena, seating, room, training, weights etc)
- 26. What is the fan support like for the hockey team?
- 27. What does it cost to go to your school for a year?
- 28. Break these costs down for me tuition, books, other fees, housing, food etc?
- 29. Do you offer athletic scholarships and if yes how much is typical for your players?
- 30. What other financial help is available to players ... aid, bursaries, academic awards etc?
- 31. What financial assistance do you see being available to me?
- 32. What is the process and timeline for receiving financial assistance?
- 33. What equipment costs are covered for your players?
- 34. Will you cover the cost for me to visit your school before making my decision?
- 35. What are the next steps in your recruitment process for me?
- 36. Do you have further questions of me?
